#### Headlice

There are continuing outbreaks of head lice throughout the school. We request that you should please check and treat (if necessary) all the family to prevent it from spreading. Please refer to HSE information sheet on school website. Thank you.



#### Uniforms

Reminder that uniforms should be worn by **all** children from 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> class **everyday** throughout the year, other than PE days, when school tracksuits should be worn or unless otherwise advised.

### Set Down Area/Parking/Access

Please be reminded that the set down area **MUST** be kept clear at all times for the safety of all children and other pedestrians. We strongly advise that the **NO PARKING** signs are strictly adhered at all times please. It is an area meant only for vehicles to pull up for a minute or two whilst collecting or dropping off children. Parents and guardians are reminded to use the car park adjacent to the school when dropping off and collecting children and NOT to park in the set down area If you will be in the set down area for more than a minute or two, then you must wait in the car park provided. If parents and guardians choose to use the car park across the road from the school, then they are required to cross the road with the children at all times, in the interest of child safety.

Vehicles MUST NOT be parked in the set down area; drivers must not leave their vehicle at any time. We have had a few occasions recently where drivers have left their vehicles in front of the school gates leaving the school bus having to wait until this area is clear before the bus can pull up to allow children to alight. We would be obliged if parents could relay this information to all family members, friends, childminders etc who drop off and collect children from the school. Please also be reminded that the school lane must be kept clear at all times; this is an area for staff parking only and access to the private farm/land; other vehicles are strictly prohibited from using the lane under any circumstances. Please also be informed that the gates at the front school entrance (the set down area) must be kept closed at all times, again in the interests of the Health & Safety of all children. Please ensure the gates are closed behind you on entry and exit.



All enrolment applications should be returned to the school by Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> February.
